* The Enhanced Medicaid matching rate is based on a temporary increase per the economic recovery package (H.R.1, the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009). States will receive the enhanced Medicaid matching rate for expenditures incurred between October 1, 2008 and December 31, 2010. The federal share of Medicaid will revert to the original FY2011 FMAP on January 1, 2011. The enhanced matching rates listed here represent the estimated average enhanced Medicaid matching rates for FY2009 and FY2010. The exact enhanced Medicaid matching rates are recalculated quarterly based on state unemployment rates. Quarterly estimates available upon request.
