Medicare's Basic Benefit:

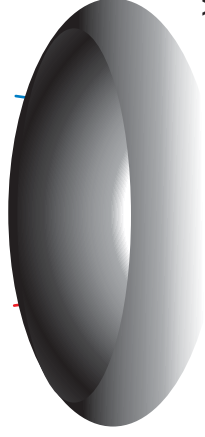
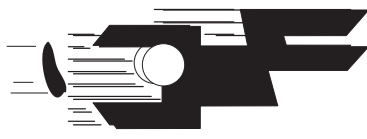
Besides the annual premium, you pay . . .



\$310 Annual Deductible
(You pay 100%)

After the deductible, you pay about 25% of Rx costs between \$310 and \$2,830 (about \$630).

You reach the \$2,830 drug coverage limit - you're headed for the Doughnut Hole

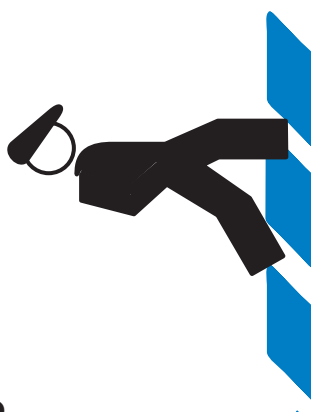


Drug costs of \$2,830 to \$6,440
You pay 100% out of pocket

You can afford the out-of-pocket drug costs, so you can work your way out of the doughnut hole.



You can't afford your drugs and must choose between health, home, and family. You are stuck in the doughnut hole.



Your coverage begins again.
(For any drug costs above \$6,440, you pay 5% and your plan pays 95%)
