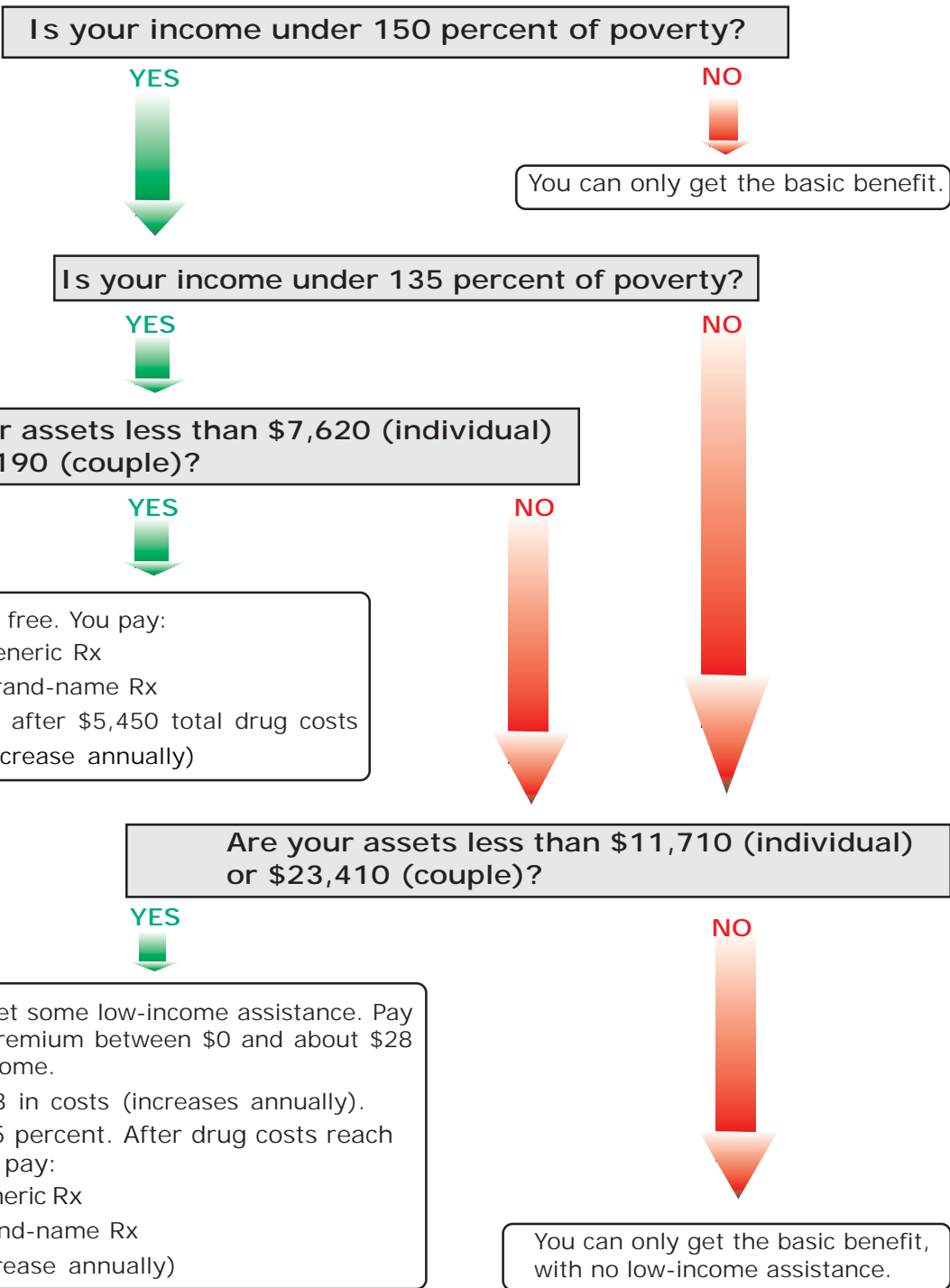

Note: If you received low-income help in 2006 and your circumstances haven't changed, you should be eligible this year and will stay in your same plan. Check with your Medicaid or Social Security office to make sure. If you are eligible for extra-help and are not yet enrolled in a plan, you may enroll any time during 2007 without a late enrollment penalty. You also have the option of changing plans at any time during the year.

You are enrolled in Medicare and not in Medicaid.
