Dear Speaker Pelosi, Chairman Neal, and Chairman Pallone,

Thank you for your steadfast leadership to address the on-going oral health crisis many families in America face. As organizations and advocates representing health care consumers, older adults, people with disabilities, patients, providers, industry, social service, and others, we are writing to express our appreciation and support for the legislation advanced in the Ways and Means and Energy and Commerce Committees that would add oral health coverage to Medicare Part B.

This extension of Medicare Part B to include dental, vision and hearing coverage is a critical piece of rebuilding our nation's health and wellbeing. Dental coverage that will ensure that oral health care is no longer unaffordable and out of reach is particularly important to economic recovery and health equity.

- Adding oral health coverage to Medicare Part B would allow 60 million older adults and people
 with disabilities to not only be able to get important dental care, but to also be healthier, have
 lower health care costs, and be better able to get and keep jobs.
- Even before the pandemic, roughly half of Medicare enrollees did not have a dental visit in the past year—often skipping care due to cost. Moreover, 68% of Black beneficiaries and 61% of Hispanic beneficiaries did not have a dental visit in the same year.

Medicare oral health coverage is overwhelmingly popular, with a recent poll finding nearly 9 in 10 voters support adding oral health coverage to Medicare. When asked which health care issues Congress should work on this year, adding Medicare dental coverage – alongside vision and hearing coverage – is far and away the most popular health care proposal that is currently on the table.

We appreciate the hard work from leadership and the committees to address and prioritize dental coverage in Medicare Part B as part of Budget Reconciliation legislation. The millions of older adults and people with disabilities across this country who rely on Medicare will finally be able to afford care that too many currently go without due to the cost.

We look forward to working with all of you, as well as your colleagues in the Senate, to move Medicare dental coverage forward and where possible, to strengthen the legislation before final passage. Our priority is to ensure that people who rely on Medicare for their health care can get the most robust dental coverage possible as quickly as is feasible. Specifically, we support improvements that would ensure that major dental services (which are the hardest to afford) are covered at 80%, in line with other Part B services, and that dental coverage reaches Medicare enrollees sooner than seven years from now.

Thank you for your leadership and for continuing the fight to ensure that families have access to affordable and quality health care, including oral health care. We look forward to working with you to secure passage of the final package.
